What do campers bring to camp every day?

- A healthy lunch (no nuts!)
- Running shoes with socks!
- Sunscreen and cap.
- Water bottle.
- Bathing suit and towel.
- On outings, campers must wear their camp T-shirt.



Entry Procedures

Camp will begin at 9:00am every day and the following procedure will be followed:

- All campers must enter the YLC via the entrance located at the rear of the building in the parking lot. The parking lot will be closed to traffic as of 8:30am.
- Grades 4,5, and 6 climb the stairs to the 2nd floor of the YLC.
- Campers not in daycare are asked to wait in the parking lot until they are welcomed by a representative of Happy Days Summer Camp.

Dismissal Procedures

Camp will end at 4:00pm every day and the following procedure will be followed:

- All Campers will be dismissed at 4pm, unless they are in daycare.
- Campers will be **dismissed** and escorted to the **YLC parking lot** by their animator where campers will wait for pick-up. The parking lot will be closed to traffic as of 3:30pm.
- To avoid confusion, we ask that all those picking up a camper who is not in daycare remain outside until your child is brought out by an animator.

Early Dismissal Procedures

- All Campers needing to be dismissed from camp before 4:00pm must submit written notice to
 the coordinators, stating when the child needs to be dismissed and who will be picking up
 the child. The letter must be signed by the parent or legal guardian of the camper.
- Those picking up a camper must submit a piece of photo ID and must sign the dismissal log.
 Those who do not present identification will not be permitted to leave with the camper.
- All dismissals will be done from the coordinator's office located on the second floor of the YLC.

Sunscreen!

- The use of sunscreen is mandatory. Please include a bottle of it in your child's bag. We recommend a sunscreen with a minimum SPF level of 30.
- Any camper that does not have sunscreen or refuses to put it on will be removed from all outdoor activities.

Daycare Procedures

- Daycare is from 7am to 9am in the mornings and 4pm to 6pm in the afternoons.
- Those picking up a camper **must provide Photo ID** (if requested by the daycare team) and sign the dismissal log.
- Those who do not present identification will not be permitted to leave with the child.
- Please ensure that daycare times are respected, those not respecting the terms of their daycare registration times will be faced with financial penalties.

Pool

- Campers of grades 4,5,6 will be using the pool located in Don Bosco Park.
- Campers should bring their bathing suits and towels with them every day.
- Parents should advise their child's animator if there are any concerns over their child's swimming ability.

Camp attire

- Campers should come dressed comfortably for the daily activities: shorts and t-shirts.
- Clothes/accessories that do not pertain to a camp lifestyle are discouraged (jeans, skirts, dresses, opened sandals, excessive jewelry, etc.)
- Campers should wear running shoes with socks every day.
- Campers are encouraged to wear respectful swimming attire (tankinis or one-piece bathing suits for girls)

*** PLEASE NOTE: We are not responsible for any stolen or damaged items. Please leave items like cell phones and video games at home. ***

The 5 Biggest Rules at Camp

- 1- Campers cannot be alone without an animator. Always stay with your animator!
- 2- No cell phones and no video games. This is camp tons of fun without these things!
- 3- Absolutely no nuts at camp.
- 4- No bullying will be tolerated. Camp is a bully free zone. No ones like a bully!
- 5- Respect! Respect your animators. Respect each other. Respect the camp.

WE DISMISS OUTSIDE AT 4pm!

In order to facilitate the dismissal of the campers, we ask that you please respect this time and wait for your children at the designated entrance at East Hill or YLC. At that moment, we will accompany them outside and you will then be able to pick up your child. Please note that campers will not be dismissed to parents waiting in their cars. We ask that you pick up your children at the entrance. For those that have children at East Hill and at the YLC. Please pick up your child at East Hill FIRST.

You have a 30 minute "grace period". Plenty of time so don't stress 😉





Dismissal can become very hectic and we understand that finding a parking spot around the school and YLC may not be an easy task. However, for the safety of all our campers and to simplify the dismissal process, we ask that you please not double park in front of East Hill school and YLC entrances. Police will be doing regular checkups and issuing tickets. Don't take the risk. Park your car and get some sunshine!



No NUT products allowed!



Bullying Definition at the YLC summer camps

The approved interpretation of what our summer camps define as bullying is; The conscious and deliberate and consistent effort by a camper or campers to belittle or damage the self-worth of another camper.

"Teasing" or random name calling is not bullying. It is at times, a common situation by some children regardless of their age. The YLC is very attentive and supportive to those children who may be suffering from bullying at their schools. Please share any information about your child's selfesteem and reputation at school. We will help them (if they are the bullies and/or getting bullied). Our goal is to empower each child in our care to become beacons of light who all have unique gifts and talents. All our campers will be reminded daily that they are all awesome kids!!!





Got Lice? Had Lice? Think your child has lice? Please alert your child's coordinator immediately!

Do not send your child to camp unless they have had treatment for at least 3 days. Do not jeopardize the participation and attendance of our camps for other children! Lice spreads quickly in a big camp setting! We know that this may put your family in a difficult situation but it's just the right thing to do! Please be aware that if as a camp team, we feel you have knowingly put other children in jeopardy, we will ask you to reimburse the days those affected children who have to miss camp days. Failure to comply will then have an effect on your child missing camp days. Please let us work together for a lice free summer! Thank you!
