



Funky Dance program information for 4yrs to High school!!! 2020-2021

Thank you for joining our fun and dynamic program!

The goal of the Funky Dance Academy is to help build confidence and friends through the art of dance. We accomplish this by teaching in a kind, patient, and vibrant way.

- **Classes begin the week of Monday, October 5th. We will notify you by a phone call or email.**
- Some dance sessions may be moved or rescheduled according to the dance instructors or the YLC's schedule. Thank you in advance for your understanding ☺
- Due to Covid...
 - We will be offering 10 sessions from October to December (50\$ per child).
 - The kids/teens will learn a minimum of 1 dance and will receive a "music video" to bring home and enjoy at home with friends and family. The filming will be part of the 10 sessions.
 - The music videos per group will also be linked to our social media and website.
 - The 2nd session (if all goes well with Covid), will have the goal of performing at our annual Youth Festival sometime in May 2021. The cost of the second session is 70\$ as there are more classes.
 - If due to Covid, we cannot present the show in May 2021, the same format of a music video will be brought home.
 - 10 kids max per group (5 minimum).
 - Parents can sign up for 1 (October to December) or both sessions (January to May). Sign up for both and receive a 10\$ rebate.
 - **Because of a Covid case or schools closing again, if we need to cancel the dance sessions for a group or groups, a credit will be given to the parents that can be used for any of the YLC or summer camp services.**

- We have 3 dance instructors with plenty of experience at the YLC and summer camp. And, various levels of dance experience. Julia Venditti is back!!! And will work with the High school dancers.

Some guidelines...

1. Please have your daughter come to the class with comfortable clothes and shoes (no jeans).
2. Please bring a mask. If forgotten, we will provide a mask. Hand washing is obligatory. Social distancing is not a guarantee because of the nature of the activity.
3. Everyone is required to wear running shoes for comfort and safety.
4. Please arrive 5 minutes early for class. The dance rooms are on the 2nd floor
5. Because of different skill levels, we might create a new time slot or invite you to switch class.
6. There are no partial reimbursements after the 2nd class.
7. Your child may also be participating in other youth related events. More info will be forthcoming.
8. Parents are welcomed to stay at the YLC 2nd floor or outside the dance room during your daughter's class.
9. Some outings or events may be planned.
10. Each class will consist of the following (in general);
 - a. Practicing various dance steps to build coordination and monitor progress of skill level.
 - b. Practicing dance routines for the music video and/or Don Bosco Youth Festival.
 - c. Building a personal relationship with each girl.
